## Forest Lawn Visit 5:00 PM, Wednesday June 25<sup>th</sup>.

Take interstate 480 north to the 48<sup>th</sup> street exit. Drive south on Morman Bridge Road, about 2 miles. Meet at 5:00 pm at the main building. First building on the right as you enter the cemetery. Park on the East side. Main gate closes at 8 PM. The Mausoleum has restrooms and a water fountain and is open until 8 pm.

## Points of interest:

- 1. Marble chapel will be our first stop and be opened for us to photograph inside. Bring wide angle lens. Intricate mosaics, stained glass and crematorium are amazing.
- 2. Civil war section with GAR statue is up the hill from chapel. Cemetery has offered to have flag up.
- 3. Bronze Elk Statue, Angel, Sheppard, bronze, Barlow, women and soldier statuary. ST on map.
- 4. Old National Cemetery section.
- 5. Garden of Meditation with large marble Bible.
- 6. Who's Who of Omaha history in several sections.
- 7. Interesting architectural monuments
  - a. Harvey monument with stained glass cross
  - b. Jacobs Monument, Storz mausoleum
  - c. Werner monument, Art Deco style
  - d. Scotts Garden, Swanson Mausoleum with pass thru window
  - e. Wasserburger monument, with bronze statute
- 8. During a tour we saw a turkey, two deer, and a hawk fly overhead with a snake in its mouth.
- 9. Pollinator garden up front. Macro lens helpful.
- 10. Zoom lens could also be helpful: ex:18 x 400

Restrooms and water will be available at the Mausoleum on the right-hand side of drive. We can combine in cars and then form a caravan. Gates close at 8:00.
